Entry Information

NOTE: SAMPLE OF EACH ENTRY MUST BE PRE-MOUNTED ON 3MM SOLID BOARD MEASURING 550mm (L) x 450mm (H)

- Entries will be accepted from any Flexographic Printer.
- All Flexographers are invited to enter. ANZFTA Membership is not a condition of entry.
- Entries from overseas must be customs cleared and prepaid. The ANZFTA cannot accept responsibility for the delays in customs clearance.
- Any entry outside Australia/New Zealand will not be eligible for the Best in Show Award but is eligible for Category Awards.
- **To be eligible for judging, each entry should be accompanied by the following:**
 - All entries will be subjected to a points scoring system for eligibility of awards.
 - Flexographic print samples from one of the eleven print categories as described herein.
 - Entries must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 5000 impressions (where applicable), and supplied on cardboard cores where required.
 - Entries should have been printed between 1 July 2008 and 30th June 2009.
 - Completed entry form. Entry Form & Tax Invoice available on our Website at www.flexoaustralia.org.au. Photocopies of the printed entry form are acceptable. All the data as requested on this entry form, must be recorded.
 - First 3 entries per category free. Each additional entry at AUD\$35 for Members & AUD\$55 for Non Members.
 - Cheques made payable to AFTA
 - Your company letterhead, with the company name, as it is to appear on any award that may be made to your company, typed on the letterhead.
- Please ensure you have your Customer approval to enter and show the work.
- Each entrant is entitled to submit up to five entries per category.
- Each entrant is entitled to submit to one or more categories.
- All entries become the property of ANZFTA, and the ANZFTA reserves the right to use the entries submitted for display and publicity.
- Best in Show winner will be eligible to enter the International Flexographic Print Awards.
- ANZFTA Judges decisions are final.

CATEGORY 1

1.0 Narrow Web (Printed on Presses up to 500mm/20inches wide)

Surface Print Paper

- 1.1.1 Colour Halftone
- 1.1.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Surface print Film

- 1.2.1 Colour Halftone
- 1.2.2 Colour Line: can include stipple

Reverse Print Film & Reverse Print Laminates

- 1.3.1 Colour Halftone
- 1.3.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

One length of ten (10) **full cylinder repeats** required at full web width. Must not be die-cut, slit or trimmed. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 5,000 impressions, and supplied on a cardboard core.

CATEGORY 2

2.0 Mid Web Flexibles (Paper and/or Film: Printed on Presses 501mm to 914mm/36 inches wide)

Surface Print Paper

- 2.1.1 Colour Halftone
- 2.1.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Surface print Film

- 2.2.1 Colour Halftone
- 2.2.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Reverse Print Film & Reverse Print Laminates

- 2.3.1 Colour Halftone
- 2.3.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

One length of ten (10) **full cylinder repeats** required at full web width. Must not be slit or trimmed. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 5,000 impressions, and supplied on a cardboard core.

CATEGORY 3

3.0 Wide Web Flexibles (Paper and/or Film: Printed on Presses 915mm upwards)

Surface Print Paper

- 3.1.1 Colour Halftone
- 3.1.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Surface print Film

- 3.2.1 Colour Halftone
- 3.2.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Reverse Print Film & Reverse Print Laminates

- 3.3.1 Colour Halftone
- 3.3.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

One length of ten (10) **full cylinder repeats** required at full web width. Must not be slit or trimmed. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 5,000 impressions, and supplied on a cardboard core.

CATEGORY 4

4.0 Folding Cartons

- 4.1 Colour Halftone
- 4.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

The same twenty (20) **consecutive cartons** from each stream required. Stream position across the web, must be numbered relative to the left hand side of the web, in the direction through the press; i.e. from the left side of the web stream No. 1, 2, 3 etc.

CATEGORY 5

5.0 Beverage Cartons & Cups

- 5.1 Colour Halftone
- 5.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

One length of ten (10) **full cylinder repeats** required at full web width. Must not be slit or trimmed. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 500 impressions.

CATEGORY 6

6.0 Preprint Liner for Corrugated Board

- 6.1 Colour Halftone
- 6.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

One length of five (5) **full cylinder repeats** required at full web width. Must not be slit or trimmed. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 500 impressions.

CATEGORY 7

7.0 Post Print for Corrugated Board

- 7.1 Colour Halftone
- 7.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

Ten consecutive boxes/sheets required. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 500 impressions.

CATEGORY 8

8.0 Tag & Label (Printed on Presses to 600mm wide)

- 8.1 Colour Halftone
- 8.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

One length of ten (10) **full cylinder repeats** required at full width of printed web. May be die-cut but not slit, must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 5,000 impressions, and supplied on a cardboard core.

CATEGORY 9

9.0 Multiwall Sacks

- 9.1 Colour Halftone
- 9.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

Ten consecutive cylinder repeats required. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 500 impressions, and supplied on a cardboard core.

CATEGORY 10

10.0 In-Line Extrusion Print

- 10.1 Colour Halftone
- 10.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

One length of ten (10) **full cylinder repeats** or ten (10) consecutive bags required at full web width. Must not be slit or trimmed. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 5,000 impressions. Only Cylinder repeats to be supplied on a cardboard core.

CATEGORY 11

11.0 Envelopes

- 11.1 Colour Halftone
- 11.2 Multi Colour Line: can include stipple

Entry Prerequisites:

Ten consecutive envelopes required. Each entry must be taken from a commercial production run of more than 500 impressions.
